Just a few reminders to keep our program running smoothly:

- **All soccer players must come to school dressed for soccer practice.** This means all soccer players need to wear their green shirt and athletic pants to school. We have a limited number of parent volunteers to watch classrooms while the teachers take our remaining students to carpool line, tie cleats, and hustle our players outside. We do not have extra supervision available to wait with those children who need to change clothes. Please help us with this endeavor as we want to be efficient with our allotted practice time.
- **All players need to wear their green soccer shirt with their name on the outside for practices and games.** This helps the coaches learn your child's name quickly! We have 60 players and 8 coaches. If you need a new shirt, please let me know.
- **Only soccer players with shin guards will be allowed to participate in practice or games.** This is a league rule and helps keep our children safe.
- **Soccer players going from practice to the Dragon's Den after school program must be signed up previously or bring a note to the office on Wednesday mornings.**
